- 2) Field visit by a NRCS natural resource professional to discuss land manager goals and priority treatment areas.
- 3) Land manager submits application to NRCS office.
- 4) Initial plan is developed by NRCS and reviewed by the land manager.
- 5) NRCS conservation plan completed by NRCS and ranked according to benefits derived from the project at a regional level.
- 6) Plan funded or denied. Denied plans can be refiled and ranked again in later funding cycles. Land manger signs contract documents if approved for funding.
- 9) Land manager responsible for completing work in contract. NCRS staff available for technical assistance.
- **10)** Project inspection by NCRS. Reimbursement released within two weeks of completion certification.
