Introduction

This work plan was developed to operate as an annual guide to implementation of programs outlined in the existing Feather River RCD Strategic Plan, adopted August 21st, 2025. The Strategic Plan identifies several Strategic Issues, with corresponding Goals and Strategies, to be addressed by the District over a one-year period. The activities proposed in this work plan relate directly back to the content of the five-year Strategic Plan, with each Issue and Goal identified by number. Each activity represents one of the Strategies from the Strategic Plan, converted to an action item. The responsible party, approximate cost and funding source for each activity is identified when possible.

Our mission is to advocate resource conservation through education and collaborative efforts with willing landowners and organizations that promote the economic and ecological sustainability of the Upper Feather River Watershed.
